Remove:

- Trash
- Pressurized Cylinders (aerosol cans, propane cylinders)
- Explosive items (chemicals, gasoline, kerosene, bullets, ammunition, fireworks)
- Oil based paintings
- Pets (including fish)
- Heirlooms (high-value items, one-of-a-kind item, family memorabilia)

Store in the Refrigerator:

- Things that melt (soaps, candles, chocolate, cosmetics)
- Things that go bad with heat (distilled liquor, medicines)

Secure articles from blowing air:

- Pictures
- Paintings
- paperwork

What to wear the day of treatment:

- Have clothes that have been in the dryer for 1 hour on high heat sealed in a bag outside your property. Once you leave, change into these clothes, and put your old clothes back in the bag. Place the old clothes in the dryer for one hour on high heat once you return.

General spaces:

- Place clothes in baskets, loosely packed to allow the heat to penetrate.
- Unplug electronic equipment
- Doors and drawers should be left open to allow for air to circulate.

Heat Treatment Preparation Checklist

The list provided on the left is a guideline. To best protect yourself, you want to do 3 things:

- 1) Move heat sensitive items to a safe place.
- 2) Create an environment where hot air can easily circulate.
- 3) Prevent an opportunity to bring bugs back into your home.
